Pets at Camp Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the safety of our Scouts and staff by streamlining Council policy with National policy and The Outdoor Code.

Policy

No dogs will be allowed in camp unless approved by the Camping Committee on a case by case basis. The owner of the dog must submit the request in writing along with proof of insurance coverage for the dog and assume all responsibility. The owner must also agree to sign a Hold Harmless Waiver stating that they assume all legal and responsibility for their pet and hold harmless BSA National and Housatonic Council, Officers and Volunteers.
